ENTRY RULES

- 1. The race is run according to the rules of ASA and WPA.
- 2. Participants in the 10km must be 14 years of age or older. Participants in the 5km must be 10 years of age or older unless accompanied by an adult.
- 3. Race numbers (bibs) will not be issued. All registered athletes must wear two valid license numbers. Unregistered participants must purchase a Temporary License which must be worn on the front of the vest.
- 4. Temporary license holders when registering MUST complete and hand in the tear off strip from the number to be eligible to compete.
- 5. Licensed athletes should wear club colours. Temporary licensed athletes must run in clothing without advertising.
- 6. To qualify for team prizes, athletes must wear full club colours and participate with a permanent license.
- 7. Age category tags must be worn (front and back) and visible for the entire race to be eligible for any age category prize.
- 8. Entry cards must be in the athlete's possession during the race and handed in at the results board at the Finish.
- 9. Cut off for all races is at 08h30. Prize-giving is at 08h30. 10. Do not litter. This is a plastic free event, meaning no plastic sachets and carry you own or water will be poured in cups. There will be 3 water stations along the route. Coke and water for all finishers. #RunClean
- 11. The use of music players with headphones is not allowed and will result in disqualification.
- 12. Detailed rules are available on www.wpa.org.za or on request from the organisers or the WPA office.
- 13. Wheelchair athletes must please contact the organisers timeously to discuss arrangements for their participation.
- 14. A tog bag area will be available at own risk.
- 15. Juniors (born in 2005 or later) wearing a senior or junior licence must display category tags "J", to qualify for age group prizes. Juniors will count towards Open team prize.
- 16. No personal seconding will be permitted except at official refreshment stations.
- 17. DISCLAIMER: Participants in this event do so at their own risk and release and discharge the organisers, sponsors, provincial and national athletics bodies and all persons assisting in staging the event from any responsibility, liability or costs relating to any injury, loss or damage of whatever nature, however caused, arising directly or indirectly from their participation in the event.
- 18. In addition to Overall (Open) prizes, participants will only be eligible for an age category prize in the age category they enter. Corresponding numerical age category tags must be worn on the front and back of their Club vest. Participants may enter the age category corresponding to their chronological age or any younger category down to
